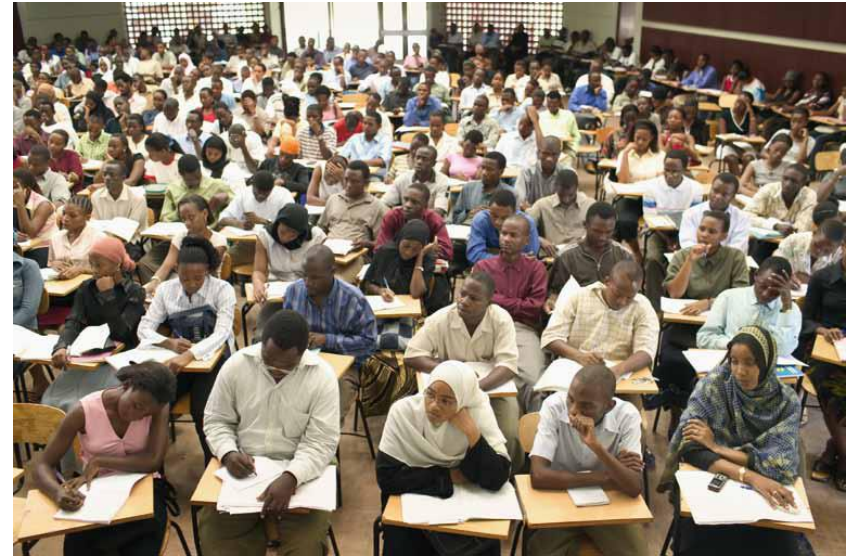

A) Technical and Vocational Skills Development

- To equip more young women and men in the informal economy with skills - improve employability
- Start up phase of 3-5 years, 18 million USD in 2-3 countries in West Africa





B) Linking university education, research and business in sustainable agriculture

- to promote innovation and entrepreneurship - collaboration between universities, research institutions, private sector
- to support capacity development of universities
- Min. 20 million USD





Competitive funds – strategic research

- Larger strategic projects with substantive elements of capacity building – researchers in the South and in Denmark.
- Institutional and individual capacity building. Enrolment national/regional.
- Individual PhD and Post doc. – DK – support resource base.
